Call for Papers for Workshop on *Oligopoly and Imperfect Labour Markets* January 27 & 28, 2022

Objective & Topic

The Institute for Labour Law and Industrial Relations in the European Union (IAAEU) at Trier University and the University of Applied Labour Studies, Mannheim, are pleased to announce a workshop on *Oligopoly and Imperfect Labour Markets*, scheduled for January 27 (afternoon) & January 28, 2022.

The virtual workshop focuses on the interaction of output market power and imperfect competition on the most important input market, namely for labour. It offers a forum for economists to discuss theoretical and empirical contributions and enhance academic cooperation. Ph.D. students are encouraged to submit their work.

Presentations may cover topics such as:

- Trade unions and oligopolistic markets
- Free entry oligopolies and imperfectly competitive upstream markets
- Asymmetric information on the labour market and output market power
- Non-standard objectives of oligopolistic firms and labour issues
- Working from home if firms have market power
