Objective & Topic

The workshop focuses on how trade unions in the western world deal with and are affected by migration. It aims to bring together junior and senior economists and other social scientists to present and discuss their research and enhance networking and academic cooperation. Ph.D.students are highly encouraged to submit their research.

- Membership decision of migrants and their descendants
- Trade unions and the integration of migrant workers
- Impact of industrial relation systems on trade unions response to migration
